

2022-2023 El Dorado Stay & Play Shuttle

Thank you for your interest in the El Dorado Stay & Play Shuttle Program. The El Dorado County Visitors Authority (EDVA) designed the program to encourage group transportation and overnight stays in El Dorado County, reduce motor vehicle emissions and introduce new visitors to the area.

The program provides funding for transportation from one or more El Dorado County lodging to regional wedding and event venues. The level of funding is based upon the number of rooms nights booked.

Qualified applicants will meet the following requirements:

20 room nights = \$500.00 contribution from EDVA to shuttle cost 30 room nights = \$750.00 contribution from EDVA to shuttle cost 40 room nights = \$1000.00 max contribution from EDVA to shuttle cost

*Lodging must be in El Dorado County

Program funds only group transportation of 20 more guests, no limos can be funded *Vacation Rentals/Airbnb are counted as one room regardless of the number of bedrooms they offer.

Please note that you will be held financially responsible for the full amount of transportation costs if you:

- Cancel your reservation less than 14 days prior to your event
- Do not meet a minimum of 20 rooms nights at any EDC Lodging
- Cause damage to the shuttle during the duration of the rental

How it works:

- 1. Review the guidelines for the program.
- 2. Complete the Stay & Play Application with as much information as you have now and email to: El Dorado Stay & Play Program Coordinator at stayandplay@eldoradocounty.org. This does not obligate you to use the program but it indicates your interest in the program and provides contact information.
- 3. You will receive a confirmation email for receipt of application.
- 4. When confident you qualify for the program, contact one of the transportation companies listed below to make a reservation. You will contracting with this company directly. Our program is designed to contribute to that cost. Please refer to the "El Dorado Stay & Play Shuttle Program" when making the reservation.

We suggest you provide shuttle pick-up and drop-off details to your guests upon check-in. We are happy to include that information in our welcome kit if requested one week prior to your event.

Frequently Asked Questions:

What's a Welcome Kit?

The El Dorado County Visitors Authority & their partners provide a bag with useful visitor information, discounts & incentives for this visit or future visits, transportation information, and a small gift for each room booked through this program. A lodging representative will present the welcome kit to the guest upon check-in.

Can I use more than one lodging to qualify for the program?

Yes, as long as all lodging is located in El Dorado County.

Can I use rooms in a private residence to qualify for the program?

No, sorry it must be a licensed commercial lodging property in good standing with the applicable county, state & federal agencies.

Do Vacation Rentals/Airbnb/ VRBO qualify for the program?

Yes as long as they are licensed commercial lodging property in good standing with the applicable county, state & federal agencies. Qualified Vacation Rentals/Airbnb/ VRBO are counted as one room per night regardless of the number of bedrooms they have.

Can I use another limousine service?

Yes, you can but certain restrictions apply. Prior approval is required. Contact the Stay and Play Program Coordinator for further details.
